## MMP Sustainable procurement policy

MMP only source tuna that caught by Pole & Line, Purse seine net fishing, and long line methods. We do not purchase tuna caught by gill net or drift net fishing method.

MMP do not engage with tuna transaction from vessels that are not registered with the Regional Fisheries Management Organizations (RFMO). We regularly assess risk of Illegal, Unregulated and Unreported (IUU) fishing by reviewing RFMO vessels blacklist.

MMP is a member of International Pole & Line Foundation (IPNLF) which advocate to improved domestic and international management for sustainable tuna fisheries. The company is certified by the Marine Stewardship Council (MSC), the globally recognized sustainability certification body.

We also support "Dolphin safe" that monitored by the Earth Island Institute (EII) to ensure that no dolphin are intentional deployed or encircled with net and no dolphin were killed or seriously injured in the net in which the tuna were caught.

Regarding shark fining, we do not endorse the practice of shark fining which is the retention of any fins while discarding the carcass at sea. We will only purchase tuna from vessel-owning companies that have published policy prohibiting shark fining on board its vessels.

The products packed by MMP are fully traceable back to caching including Fishing vessels name, flag of fishing vessels and carrier vessels, Species of fishes, Fishing trip date, FAO are of fishing, Fishing gear employed and dated that company took ownership of the fish and each species weight.
